#### Service and Operation Data:

1. Authorized and performed: Parks and recreation services; uses private contractors to provide some services.
2. Latent powers: Fire protection, garbage collection and disposal, and street lighting, if not otherwise provided and if authorized by Board of Supervisors.

Facilities: Eleven *district owned parks* - Ashton Park, Eastern Oak Park, Gibbons Park, Maddox Park, Mission North Park, Oak Meadow Park, Orville Wright Park, Shelfield Park, Swanston Park, Valley Oak Park, and Windermere Park. 88.75 acres.

Four *school parks* – Cowan School Park, Del Paso Manoir School Park, Greer School Park and Sierra Oaks School Park. 13.7 acres.

Facilities – Swanston Community Center and Mission Oaks Senior Citizen/Community Center.

#### Historical and Political Data:

1. Windemere Recreation and Park District was established on November 26, 1958; Mission Oaks Recreation and Park District established in January 1975. The two districts merged on September 7, 1993.
2. Enabling Act: Public Resources Code, Section 5780.
3. Governing Body: Board of Supervisors, ex officio.
4. No. on Governing Body Members: Five-member Advisory Board of Directors, appointed by the Board of Supervisors.
5. The board meets on the 1<sup>st</sup> Thursday of the month.
