DISCUSSION:

Municipal Service Reviews

Sacramento LAFCo requires Municipal Service Reviews for Spheres of Influence Amendments, annexations, reorganization, change of organizations, authorization of latent powers, and with any other similar action requiring Commission approval. The following process is proposed to complete MSR's set forth in this report. Nineteen (19) MSR's have been completed and fifteen (15) are currently in progress. Ten (10) MSR's will be commenced this year. The proposed work plan is discussed in the following sections:

Proposed MSR Process

- 1. Streamline MSR Questionnaire
- 2. Collaborate with affected Districts to fill out questionnaire in Word document format and provide other required information in electronic format to facilitate information sharing and preparing a standardized MSR report.
- 3. LAFCo staff evaluates response to questionnaires and conducts public outreach

- 4. Staff prepares Draft MSR utilizing information provided in Word format and schedules a public hearing
- 5. Staff prepares Final MSR for Commission approval

(Note: There are two types of levee systems in the Delta: Federal project levees and non-project levees. Federal project levees were constructed as part of the Federal flood control projects along portions of the Sacramento and American Rivers. These levees are maintained to Federal Standards by the State of California.

Non-project levees are classified as either private or direct-agreement levees. Non-project levees are privately owned and maintained. Neither the Federal government or the State have jurisdiction over these levees.

Reclamation Districts are authorized to reclaim land by the construction of levees, provide irrigation water, provide drainage facilities, and provide for the operation and maintenance of these facilities. Basically, Reclamation Districts were formed by landowners to reclaim land for agricultural production. There are twenty two Reclamation Districts that provide reclamation services to protect agricultural operations in the Delta in order to continue farming and ranching operations.

The maintenance, service levels, and assessments are determined by the landowners who directly benefit from their levee system).
